

CLASSROOM BEHAVIOR PLAN

On the first day of school, the students and I discuss our classroom rules and the behaviors needed for success throughout the school year. Our five classroom rules will be the basis from which they earn positive and negative consequences for their behavior. Classroom behavior will be monitored with a "color chart" in which students move their clothespin when making exceptionally good choices (move up) or when needing redirection from the teacher (move down). Every student begins a new day on green. The values for each color are as follows:

Purple	Blue	Green	Yellow	Orange	Red
Super Student!	Excellent Effort	Ready to Learn	Make Better Choices	Teacher's Choice	Parent Contact
Add a sticker to their clothespin & a Good Choices note is sent home!		Students begin here daily.	Warning	Lose 5-10 minutes of recess or similar consequence	Miss all of recess and a note is sent home.

Note: A weekly record sheet will be sent home in Friday Folders to inform you of your child's classroom behavior. At the end of each day, students will record their color. Please keep an eye out for this half-sheet.

Classroom Rules:

1. Listen when your teacher (or someone) is talking.
2. Follow directions quickly.
3. Respect others, respect yourself, and respect your school
4. Raise your hand to speak or get out of seat.
5. Be safe, be kind, and be honest.

Possible Positive Consequences:

- Verbal or written praise
- Good behavior coupon- given to students whose behavior did not move below green for the week.
- A pull from the "Candy Jar" or new "fancy-schmanancy" pencil
- Moving up on the behavior chart/earning stickers for clothespin and colored clothespins.

Possible Negative Consequences:

- Verbal redirection or warning
- Loss of privileges (recess times, free-choice time, etc.)
- Time in buddy room or office
- A note or phone call home
- Conference with teacher
